

## PARENT PARTNERSHIP COMMITMENT

As we equip your students to engage with the world, we require that you agree with and support the Tenets of Faith found in the ACA Bylaws & Constitution and commit to the following:

- 1. Regular church attendance and service. [Hebrews 10:24-25]
- 2. Sacrificial giving by supporting ACA with the resources available to you, e.g. money, time, experience. [2 Corinthians 9:7]
- 3. Display Christ-like behavior in all interactions.
- 4. Treat everyone with humility, respect, compassion, and understanding. [Colossians 3:12-14]
- 5. Encourage and lift one another up [Ephesians 4:29; Romans 14:19].
- 6. Speak truth in love. [Ephesians 4:15]
- 7. Avoiding gossip and arguments; seek unity. [2 Timothy 2:23-24; 1 Corinthians 1:10]
- 8. Partner with ACA to work through student behavioral issues as outlined in the Student Handbook. [Proverbs 3:11-12]
- 9. Steps for conflict resolution and restoration that honors God. [Matthew 18:15-16]
  - a. Seek a one-to-one conversation for resolution;
  - b. If unresolved, request a meeting with the Principal;
  - c. If unresolved, request a meeting with the Head of School;
  - d. If unresolved with the administration, request to meet with the board by contacting the Board Chairman and Secretary, in writing, to be included on a meeting agenda.
