



ANKENY CHRISTIAN ACADEMY STATEMENT OF UNDERSTANDING

1. Students at ACA must come from a home where at least one parent has a Christian testimony.
2. At ACA we value family involvement in church. It is our expectation that all of our students and their families grow in the Lord through the ministry of a local church.
3. Students may be dismissed from ACA for violations of the Student Conduct Code.
4. Registration fees are non-refundable and are due at the time of registration.
5. The cost of education at ACA exceeds the amount provided by tuition. For this reason we seek additional funding sources and need to expect prompt payment of tuition on the first day of each month. Late charges may be assessed after the tenth day of each month.
6. If an account is two months delinquent, students may lose the right to attend classes at ACA.
7. Parents are expected to pick up children if they are too ill to attend classes.
8. Our school is run by a school board that is elected by the Association. The Association is made up of all parents and guardians. Please plan on attending association meetings to have your voice heard and to keep our school strong.
9. As misunderstandings arise between students or parents and teachers or administrators please give thoughtful prayer to the situation before you call.
