### Grandparents' Day at ACA!

# Parking & Pick-Up

- Thank you to parents that are following directions for pick up and drop off. The elementary/east side is doing really well!
- Please use this year's signs that you received at back to school night; please DO NOT use signs from previous years. They are specifically color-coordinated for specific dismissal times to help us know when you are supposed to be picking kids up. If you need another sign printed, please contact the office.
- Remember that the parking lot has cones to block parking from the elementary side. If you need to park, you need to come in on the west side and follow along the car line to park in senior parking. If you park in the morning, please be very quick all of the spots south of the gym are used for senior parking and we may need to ask you to move if a senior needs their parking spot.
- Parents CANNOT enter the parking lot earlier than their dismissal time. If you attempt to come earlier than
  your child's dismissal time, you will be expected and asked to circle the block until their designated pickup
  time (even if you're just two minutes early). Parents are allowed to come later than their designated pick-up
  time, too.

# First Grade Parent Meeting

First Grade parents - reminder that there is an important first grade parent meeting on Thursday, September 4 from 5:30-6:30 in the auditorium. This will be an overview of first grade and include instructions on how to use JMC and Google classrooms, which will be very important for you to know how to use and navigate throughout the year. This meeting is for parents only, and childcare will not be provided. One parent must attend this meeting, and it's helpful to have both parents attend the meeting.

# Elementary Schedule Changes

Lots of changes to our elementary schedule are happening this year! Many are to help us provide the educational minutes that help our students to be successful and support our value of academic excellence. We wanted to provide you some insight as your children may have some questions regarding the new schedule.

• Some students may be wondering why they have only one PE class each week. Mrs. Williams teaches BG-12th grades. While they only have it once a week, they do get a longer amount of time with Mrs. Williams

for PE class.

• Some may be wondering why they only have one recess time - we lengthened their lunch recess and removed the afternoon one. We are still well above the state requirements which state 30 minutes a day of being active, and we have that every day!

With just a few of these small changes, we are able to better ensure that our students are receiving the academic minutes they need to be successful and still get the fun and necessary movement in recess and PE!

Volunteer Roles:

TA's (Teacher's Assistants) and 3rd Parent Helpers-This shift is from 10:40am-11:40pm approximately. These volunteers help students at the kitchen window and then aid students in the cafeteria with their lunchtime needs. They also aid in cleanup as classes are dismissed.

Lunch Servers--This shift is from 10:30am-1:30pm approximately. Lunch servers serve lunch for our students and then aid in kitchen clean up.

Substitute Volunteers-These are volunteers who fill in for volunteers (TA's, 3rd Parent Helpers, and Lunch Servers) who are unable to serve on their regularly scheduled shift. This may be short notice or advanced notice. There is a great need for volunteers for our substitute volunteer lists. If you have a flexible schedule (even if it's only one day per week), please consider joining our substitute volunteer lists.

Lunch Service -- This shift is from 10:30am-1:30pm approximately

Monday--The 4th Monday of each month.

Tuesday--The 2nd and 4th Tuesdays of each month

Wednesday--The 1st Wednesday of each month

Thursday--The 3rd and 5th (where applicable) Thursdays of each month

TA -- This shift is from 10:40am-11:40pm approximately

No regular shift openings at this time. Volunteers are welcome to join the "substitute list" for these openings! Substitutes are always needed regularly throughout the school year!
