High School Retreat

We are excited for the high school retreat on September 4 and 5! The retreat will be led by Mr. Willis, our discipleship director, and many of our staff will present to the students as well as they focus on pursuing Jesus. Here

are some items to note:

- Lunch and snacks will be provided. If you need a gluten or dairy-free lunch, please email Mrs.Bogaards before Wednesday.
- Please plan to go straight to Ankeny Baptist Church in the morning and pick up from the church; there will
 not be transportation from the school to the church. Students will be dismissed at 3:20 on Thursday and 1:20
 on Friday. Seniors need to plan to attend both days, all day.
- Students only need to bring a bible and a water bottle. Notebooks and pens will be provided.
- Cell phones will not be collected that day, but students are encouraged to leave them at home or in their
 cars. The same rules and disciplinary steps will apply at the retreat students should not have their phones
 out.
- If your child needs to leave the retreat either day for any reason, <u>please fill out this form</u>. Your child will
 not be able to leave unless the form is completed.
- We will need volunteers to help serve lunch! If you're able, <u>please sign up here.</u> You must have a <u>background check completed</u> with Mrs. Frericks prior to volunteering.

Secondary Parking Reminders

- Please remind your students that they should be listening for their name to be called and they should leave immediately after hearing their name.
- Once you have picked up your kids in the carline, if you are able you can pass on the right and create a second line to exit the parking lot.
- Please pull all the way up to the tree our goal is to get as many cars off of Sharmin as possible so that we can keep the flow of traffic open on that street.
- We are discouraging parking on Sharmin to pick up your kids, but if you do, please park past the ACA entrance so parents do not assume you're waiting in line for carline.
- If you attempt to enter the parking lot from the south, you will be asked to go down and turn around so you can enter from the north.

Students

- High school juniors and seniors Don't leave your parking spot until the parking lot staff gives permission.
 It is important that we get the parents off of Sharmin street, which is why we ask you to wait until the carline is done. It is easier for you to leave if you back into your parking spot.
- After you are dismissed and have your things from the locker, please go to pick up your siblings and stay in
 the lunch room to listen for your name. We should not have to call your name more than 3 times.
- If you are participating in a fall sport, you need to be in your assigned classroom or the gym. You should not be in the lunchroom socializing
- No one can wait in the west lobby until we give them permission which is when only a few students are left and the parking lot staff has come back into the building.

Volunteer Roles:

TA's (Teacher's Assistants) and 3rd Parent Helpers-This shift is from 10:40am-11:40pm approximately. These volunteers help students at the kitchen window and then aid students in the cafeteria with their lunchtime needs. They also aid in cleanup as classes are dismissed.

Lunch Servers--This shift is from 10:30am-1:30pm approximately. Lunch servers serve lunch for our students and then aid in kitchen clean up.

Substitute Volunteers-These are volunteers who fill in for volunteers (TA's, 3rd Parent Helpers, and Lunch Servers) who are unable to serve on their regularly scheduled shift. This may be short notice or advanced notice. There is a great need for volunteers for our substitute volunteer lists. If you have a flexible schedule (even if it's only one day per week), please consider joining our substitute volunteer lists.
